8. Models of Learning

Update was given by Director of Learning Don Smith. There are successes and struggles with APEX. Students who do not earn passing grades in all APEX classes, will not have the option to re-enroll second semester. A survey will be sent out to all virtual families, including Elementary, asking about intentions for the second semester, if given option would they continue virtual instruction, if WCSD did not offer a virtual option what would the families plan be. At the first meeting in December the WCSD Board of Education will make a formal decision regarding continuing or not continuing with Elementary Virtual, option of MS/HS APEX. Most likely

based on data and survey information the Administration may ask that virtual options to be closed to new students, only offered to those students currently in the program. There were Many concerns voiced by the Board of Education surrounding the passing/failing of many students enrolled in the virtual APEX program. Contact is being made by Winneconne Administration with those families in concern, mentoring is being offered. There is an accountability factor as well responsibility by the families to make sure their children are logging in and taking the instruction offered virtually by APEX. With the cost to the WCSD and academic concerns, the future of offering this Virtual option is apparent. Across all grade levels the questions of inequity of Learning is a major concern each day forward.
