# **5.COMMUNITY SURVEY DEVELOPMENT**

The Board of Education met to review options and to discuss language for the upcoming community survey. The review of Community Survey timeline and listing of priorities was determined. The priorities reviewed were Priority 1: Renovate Middle School (28.3 million), Priority 2: Renovate Middle School and Increase Classroom Capacity (37.4 million), and Priority 3: Renovate Middle School, increase Classroom Capacity and/or Increase Gym space (43.8 million). Each of these priorities include (2.0 million) for High School parking lot

reconstruction. The PR/Marketing Committee will be working on putting the language together for a possible board approval at the September 19, 2022, Regular Board of Education Meeting.
